The course has experienced several major renovations over the years while always maintaining the integrity and quality that Ridgewood is known for. Ridgewood is currently working with the golf course architecture firm Tripp Davis and Associates to implement a comprehensive Master Plan for the course. Construction is scheduled to begin in 2023 which includes the renovation of greens, bunkers, tees, practice facilities, and other major improvements.
